ABOUT OUR STAFF

OSU Medicine is an osteopathic teaching clinic. When you are seen at OSU Medicine, it will be under the care of a full team of medical professionals. This team may include board-certified physicians, as well as residents and medical students. Our goal is to provide you with the highest quality medical and surgical care.

At any given time, you may see an entire team of clinicians participating in your health care. Based on training and function within our health care team, caregivers may be referred to as:

ATTENDING PHYSICIAN

A Board-Certified physician who is an OSU Medicine faculty member and leads the healthcare team that consists of residents, and medical students. He or she is ultimately responsible for your treatment and plan of care.

RESIDENT AND/OR FELLOW

Physicians who have received their medical degree and are training in a specialty environment. Fellows continue training after graduation and have elected to pursue advanced training.

MEDICAL STUDENTS

Third- and fourth-year students who may be involved in your care as part of their preparation to become physicians but will only work under the supervision of the attending physician.

It is normal for your care team to rotate and for several doctors to be involved in your treatment and plan of care.

Although the attending physicians may rotate, the quality of your care will not diminish because the entire health care team is tightly coordinated to provide you with the best possible care!

One of the great benefits of a teaching facility like ours is that you will receive extra attention, both clinically and personally!
